Online tool launched by Trade Mark Registry for making request for correction of clerical errors in the Trade Marks records

The Controller General of Patents Designs and Trade Marks has now launched an online tool that would enable the applicants, registered proprietor or their agents to make online request for correction of clerical or typographical errors in the Trade Marks records.

The online tool would also facilitate the applicants/ agents to upload supporting documents to substantiate their request for amendment in any data entry of the application for registration of trademarks or in the records of registered trademarks.

If applicable the competent officer of the Registry will correct the relevant records after scrutinizing the requests thus made (on the basis of existing records at the registry and the supporting documents submitted with the request).

The notification further clarifies that the said online facility is only meant for making request for the correction of clerical / typographical errors in the data entry and not for the recordal of any change or amendment that has taken place during the course of application or registration.
